

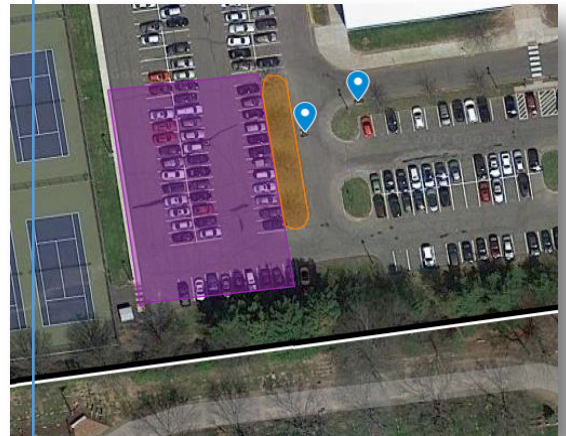
Wanted:

Stormwater Superheroes

The UConn Center for Land Use Education and Research (CLEAR) has two opportunities for those interested in stormwater management, green infrastructure, and money:

FOR UNDERGRADS:

We are hiring four (4) undergraduates for a full summer of work at \$12/hour, to help develop plans for municipalities to identify and prioritize areas for the disconnection of impervious cover. This job will come with training on green infrastructure/low impact development practices, how to design them, and on using a combination of internet mapping and field techniques.



FOR A LUCKY GRAD STUDENT:

We have funds to support a Level II graduate student at 20 hours/week for a full calendar year. This person would work closely with the CLEAR/NEMO team, provide coordination and supervision of the undergraduate team, and be responsible for assembly of the final reports to the municipalities.
